

Description of the measures to be implemented to mitigate the impact of dewatering on Cooper's lemming vole.

1. Troilus Gold is committed to dewatering in a way that limits the time of flooding of Cooper's Lemming Vole habitat.
2. Troilus Gold is committed to carrying out a program to revegetate areas near cooper's lemming vole habitat. This will facilitate the temporary relocation of Cooper's Lemming Voles until the end of the dewatering of the pits J4 and 87.

The vegetation types that will be planted there will be the following:

1. Calculated cassandrae (winter power source)
 2. Gaylussacia baccata (food source during summer period)
 3. Gray's Sedge (stabilization of the surroundings of water, tolerates flooding, used by the Vole for its trails and as a reserve)

4. Forage sedge (used by the Vole for its trails and as a reserve)
